Our <b>First Day of School for Grades 1-4</b> is Wednesday, August 17, 2022!</p> <p>Here is some additional helpful information.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>If you purchased a supply kit from Teacher Tailored Kits, you will still need to provide the following items: a backpack or bookbag, an old adult sized t-shirt to be used as an art shirt, and a lunch box if needed</li> <li>Put your child's name on <u>ALL</u> school supplies, <u>unless otherwise stated in your child's list</u>.</li> <li>All students will be provided a zippered pouch from our PTO.</li> <li>Please remember, <u>no binders, pencil sharpeners, or mechanical pencils</u> unless your child's teacher has specifically requested these items.</li> <li>All 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> grade students will be provided an assignment planner in the fall.</li> <li>Gym shoes will not be required to be kept at school this year. However, your child <u>will be required to wear tennis shoes</u> on their class gym days.
